Introduction



Audio aids

Radio

Radio is one of the learning aids to gain language skills. All India Radio has in its regular programs. Gramophone

It is one of the audio teaching aids which is not in much use at present. It can be used to record the best pronunciation and accent and the clarity of language by an English teacher and can be replayed to the students in the class room but care to be taken at the time of recording. It also can be used to record motivational speeches by eminent speakers, writers, poets and replayed to the students so that students can be inspired by them and create interest towards English language and learn beautiful expressions from the great speakers.

Tape recorder

Tape recorder is a good audio aid to train the students in listening skills and it offers good opportunities to students who try to study in distance mode. Most of the universities are offering different courses through distance mode. To gain all four types of skills, correct accent and pronunciation in English language, tape recorders are more helpful. Good informative lectures have

been given by well qualified professors in the universities like EFLU that can be recorded in cassettes and used by the people who cannot attend to the lectures directly. In the process of learning English language, one can record their own voice and can be evaluated by one self. Television programs, live speeches, motivational lectures can be recorded and played in the class room.

Visual aids

Black and white board

It is a mode of encouraging students to come out to the board to draw some pictures and ask him/her to describe in simple English. To teach a lesson or a chapter in an effective way, divide the board into two parts. Use the first part to introduce new terminology of the lesson by giving the family of that particular word and write grammatical points of the lesson and explain. The second part of the board is to be used to write the theme lines of each paragraph one by one so that a teacher can connect and consolidate all the points easily at the end.

Maps

Maps are useful material in training English speaking activities to describe route of some place and also used in an activity like giving directions to the people who are new to the place.

Flannel board

This is one of the important teaching and training materials to motivate students to make posters on various issues and are to be displayed in the flannel board and also used to display collages prepare by students on different concepts. Collage will make students more active and enhance their logical thinking.

Pictures and models

English language laboratory is the platform where students can improve their listening and speaking skills. Describing a picture or a person is one of the activities in which a student can acquire knowledge on various topics and present them before their peer group. This activity trains the students how to manage a description of picture or personality more effectively.
